

National Lunch Program

All schools in the Diocese of Covington who participate in the National School Lunch Program will begin participating in an expanded program offered by the U.S.D.A. This program has been offered as a way to provide relief to families during the pandemic and ensure all students have access to meals.

St. Pius X School will begin participation in this program beginning Monday, October 5th and will continue through June 4th, 2021 or until federal funds have been depleted. During this time, students will receive complimentary meals. This means, all students may choose a breakfast and lunch grab-n-go at no cost to the family.

As part of the program, our school will offer these complimentary meals to children who are not enrolled in our school. This means families with younger children may preorder meals and pick them up at the designated time and location. Children up to 18 years of age are eligible for the free meal.
