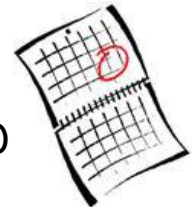

## Principally Speaking

Dear Parents,

I hope this issue of Paw Prints finds you happy and healthy. September has arrived and the weather is beautiful! I am so happy that many of you are following the drop off procedures in the morning and afternoon. Working together, we can keep all of the children safe.

As we begin our second month of school, most children are less anxious. As grades are entered into Ascend and you receive daily emails, many parents are anxious and contacting teachers. Please try to remain calm and remember that many teachers grade on a point system. When receiving grade notifications keep in mind that even though grades appear to be concerning, it may be due to the low point value attached to the grade. For example, a child may take a five-point formative assessment and get one wrong. In Ascend this appears as a "C" because it is equal to an 80%. This looks concerning but try to remember that a five point assessment is not going to impact the total grade as much as a 100 point test will. As always, know that you can call or email teachers with your concerns or questions.

As we head into this beautiful Labor Day weekend, take time with the Lord and one another. It is our Lord's grace that enables us to grow closer to Him and to love one another as perfectly as He.

Dear Missing Summer Break,

Let your child know they are not alone. A lot of students have a hard time returning back to school after summer break (some teachers too!) Here are a few tips to try to ease the back to school anxiety and fear:

- **Check your feelings at the door.** If you are nervous about your child returning to school, they will feel it too.
- **Make your goodbyes quick.** Long goodbyes can prolong your child's fear and anxiety about going to school. A quick hug, kiss and "have a good day" is all they need.
- **Be careful about saying "I'll miss you."** While you think this may be helping your child feel loved while they're away, you may in fact be causing your child to feel worried about you. Instead try something like "I can't wait to hear about your day later" or "I'll see you at dinner time".
- **Write your child an encouraging note.** Packing a short note in your child's lunchbox or backpack can give them a nice surprise to look forward to.
- **Avoid walking your child in after the first week.** Your child needs to know they can do it on their own.

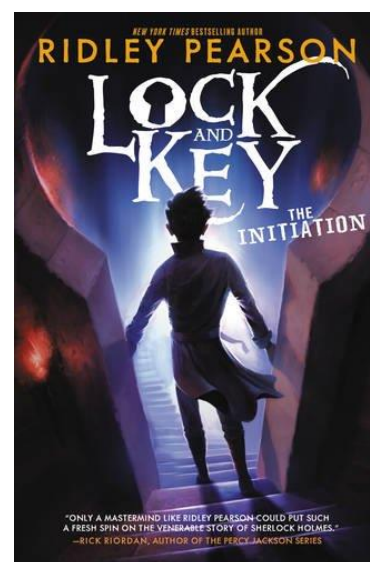

TO (RE-)ENROLL--IF YOU HAVE ALREADY REGISTERED YOUR KROGER PLUS CARD ACCOUNT:

1. Go to [www.kroger.com](http://www.kroger.com).
2. CLICK on the "SIGN-IN" Icon in the top RIGHT corner of the screen.
3. Enter your email address and password for Kroger and click on SIGN IN.
4. It could take you to the "Account Summary" page. If it did not, you need to click on the "Welcome Back" Icon (TOP RIGHT) or click on "Community/Community Rewards".
5. Scroll down to the "Community Rewards" Section and if you see an "Enroll" or "Re-enroll" icon, click here now.
6. Enter the Organization Number: 80036. Click 'SEARCH'.
7. You should see: St. Pius PTG, 348 Dudley Road, Organization #80036. You will CLICK on the little circle to the LEFT of the St. Pius name.
8. Click on "ENROLL" icon and your change will be saved.
9. If you see a green message, "Your enrollment in the Community Rewards Program has been updated. Thank you for participating!" at the top of the screen, all went well!
