

Rising 7th Grade Summer Math Assignment

Every incoming 7th grader is expected to complete the IXL skills from the list of skills found under "My Dashboard," and then "From Your Teacher" **to at least 80%**. These skills are also linked [here](#). Due to the fact that IXL can add or change the names of skills, be sure the IXL code matches what is on the list given to you.

The purpose of the summer math assignment is to give the students continued practice over the summer months. IXL was chosen because:

1. It provides video instruction if a student needs to review a given topic.
2. It provides a review of essential skills that were taught this last school year.

The skills can be completed at your own pace and in any order. Ideally, it would be spread out across the summer. If help is needed on a particular skill, IXL provides help videos. If you don't complete this assignment over the summer, full credit will not be given and you may have to continue working on it during recess once school resumes in August.

This is a 20 point assignment and will be your first math grade in 7th grade. You may earn extra credit for reaching 100% mastery on the majority of the skills and more extra credit if you achieve 100% mastery on all of the suggested skills. If you already have 80% - 100%, you must still complete a few problems to reclaim that score. Do not skip over skills just because you may have reached the goal earlier in the 6th grade.
